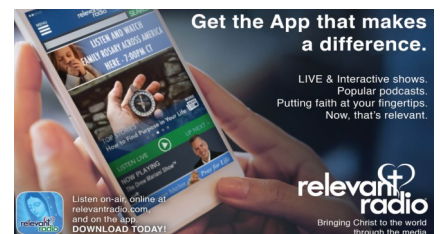

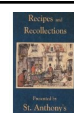
Please arrange an appointment with a priest at least eight months before the proposed wedding date to allow time for all necessary marriage preparation.
